Important Information

- Payment is required within 7 days from the date Council requests payment. After this, if the animal is found at large, it will be impounded by Council and infringements may apply.
- Tags: Your registration tag(s) will remain valid for the lifetime of your animal(s) provided the registration fee is paid annually. Replacement tags can be obtained free-of-charge from any Customer Experience Centre.
- **Registration Year:** Registrations are due on 10th April every year.
- Permits for Multiple Pets: Under Council's Local Law No. 1 General Public Amenity (2021), it is an offence to keep more than two [2] dogs or two [2] cats on a property without a permit. Contact Council for information and permit application forms.
- Restricted Breeds: In Victoria are as follows; Pit Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Fila Mastiff, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa or Perro De Presa Canario
- * Declared Dogs: If your dog/s have been declared as dangerous or menacing by another Council, you must advise the Community Safety Team. Domestic Animal Act 1994 and accompanying regulations apply.
- Working Dogs: Means a dog that herds, droves, protects, tends or works stock on land used solely or primarily for primary production. Dogs used for vermin control are not considered working dogs. Example breeds include but not limited to: Border Collie, Kelpie, Heeler, Maremma. Working dog statutory declaration must be completed.
- *Approved Organisations: You may be eligible for the reduced rate if both you and your pet are registered with an approved organisation including Dogs Victoria, Australian National Cats Inc, Feline Control Council (Vic) Inc, The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia and Victoria Inc, Master Dog Breeders and Associates (MDBA) AND includes Responsible Pet Breeders Australia (RPBA) * You can view the list of applicable organisations accepted by the State Government at https://agriculture.vic.gov.au/livestock-and-animals/animal-welfare-victoria/domestic-animals-act/registration-legislation-andpermits/dog-and-cat-registration.
