<b>Category 2: Standard Registration – CAT Only \$140</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any cat not described under Category 1</li> </ul>	<b>Category 5: Declared Menacing Dog \$216</b> Any declared Menacing dog
<b>Category 3: Standard Registration – DOG Only \$158</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any dog not described in category 1</li> </ul>	<b>Category 6: Declared Dangerous/ Restricted Breed Dog \$325</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A declared Dangerous or Restricted Breed dog</li> </ul>
<b>Transferring from another Council - \$10.00</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be an active registration</li> <li>Transfers can only occur within Victoria</li> <li>Proof Required</li> </ul>	<b>Purpose Built Cat Enclosure \$24.50</b> For desexed or cats over 10 years of age that reside in a purpose built cat enclosure.
	<b>Pension Discount – 50%</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Available only on Category 1, 2 &amp; 3</li> <li>Only eligible for persons with a Pensioner Concession Card, Veteran’s Affairs Card or Veteran’s Affairs War Widow Card</li> <li>Health Care Cards are not accepted.</li> </ul>

### Important Information

- **Tags:** Your registration tag(s) will remain valid for the lifetime of your animal(s) provided the registration fee is paid annually. Replacement tags can be obtained free-of-charge from any Customer Service Centre.
- **Registration Year:** Registrations are due on 10<sup>th</sup> April every year.
- **Permits for Multiple Pets:** Under Council’s Local Law No. 1 – General Public Amenity (2021), it is an offence to keep more than two [2] dogs or two [2] cats on a property without a permit. Unless the dogs are kept exclusively for droving or drafting livestock in a rural area or you live in a Farming Zone. Contact Council for information and permit application forms.
- **Restricted Breeds:** In Victoria are as follows; Pit Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Fila Mastiff, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa or Perro De Presa Canario
- **Working Dogs:** Means a dog that herds, droves, protects, tends or works stock on land used solely or primarily for primary production. Dogs used for vermin control are not considered working dogs. Breeds include; Border collie, Kelpie, Blue Heeler, Maremma. Working dog statutory declaration must be completed.
- **Approved Organisations:** You may be eligible for the reduced rate if both you and your pet are registered with an approved organisation including Dogs Victoria, Australian National Cats Inc, Feline Control Council (Vic) Inc, The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia and Victoria Inc, AND includes Master Dog Breeders and Associates (MDBA) \* You can view the list of applicable organisations accepted by the State Government at <https://agriculture.vic.gov.au/livestock-and-animals/animal-welfare-victoria/domestic-animals-act/registration-legislation-and-permits/dog-and-cat-registration>.
- **Transferring from another Municipality:** Your pet can be transferred from another Victorian council as long as proof of registration is provided. The only fee that will apply when transferring is \$10.00.
