


Communication channels - best way to communicate













2023 roadside drains performance (index scores)







GP2. You earlier rated the performance of roadside drains in your area as [average / poor / very poor], can you specify which particular locations are of concern?



2023 gender identity (%)





2023 Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander (%)




GP34. Do you identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander? Base: All respondents (n=400).

2023 disability (%)




