STAGE 2 – Draft Growth Scenario Consultation findings

The Draft Growth Scenario proposes growth in:

- **Cambrian Hill** (2020-30)
- **Stonehaven** (2030-40)
- Meredith*, Lethbridge and Teesdale (2040-50) *Subject to sewerage

The Growing Places Strategy (GPS) is:

A high-level plan for where future housing and population growth could be located with an action plan to support this growth.

We need the GPS to:

Make sure there is enough land available to provide homes for our share of Victoria's growing population.

Funded by the Victorian Government, the GPS involves six stages:

STAGE 1: Background research - *complete*



STAGE 2: Developing and testing a future growth scenario

STAGE 3: Preparing and consulting on a draft GPS and action plan

STAGE 4: Adopting a final GPS

STAGE 5: Preparing and consulting on a Planning Scheme Amendment to incorporate the GPS into the Golden Plains Planning Scheme (the 'rule book')

STAGE 6: Submitting the Planning Scheme Amendment to the Minister for Planning for final approval.
