At the Annual Mannibadar Lunch in June 2023, all residents who were present discussed Projects they would like undertaken over the next four years. Following this, the Mannibadar Community was asked for ideas and projects via a survey distributed through communications networks. The draft plan was then sent out to the community for comment before finalising the plan.

Drinking water access for the Hall

Activities proposed include:

Undertake plumbing assessment and engage with Council to plan the works.

Benefit to community:

As a critical community asset, Mannibadar residents and visitors rely on access to drinking water at the Hall as part of our community celebrations and in the case that the Hall is used as a refuge during emergencies.
