

DISABLED PARKING PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

Types of disability parking permits

Within the categories one or two there are 4 codes to select from depending on whether permit is for a driver, passenger, organisation or temporary:

- Code A – for a driver or passenger who has a significant intellectual or ambulatory disability
- Code B – for a passenger only who has a significant intellectual or ambulatory disability
- Code C – for organisations transporting individuals with a disability
- Code D – for a temporary permit

Disabled Permit Categories

Category 1 – Blue (available for driver or passenger)

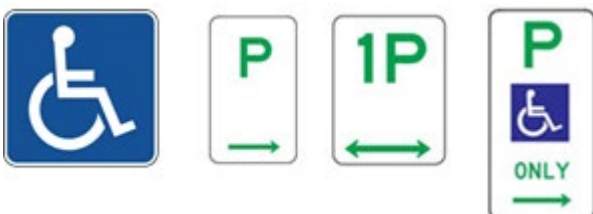
A medical practitioner must confirm the individual:

- Has a significant ambulatory disability and cannot access a vehicle in an ordinary parking bay or are required to use a complex walking aid; or
- Has either acute or chronic illness which minimal walking may endanger health; or
- Is an extreme danger to themselves and others in a public place without assistance by a carer



Where can a category 1 permit park:

- Twice as long in a timed car parking space.
- If paid parking space you pay for half the amount of time you use. Eg: park in 2P space, pay for 2 hrs and entitled to an additional 2hrs free of charge.
- Can park in reserved disability parking bays displaying International Symbol of Access (ISA)



Category 2 – Green (available for driver or passenger)

A medical practitioner must confirm the individual:

- Has a significant ambulatory disability or severe illness which does not affect ability to walk, however they require rest breaks when continuous walking undertaken



Where can a category 2 permit park:

- Twice as long in a timed car parking space
- If paid parking space you pay for half the amount of time you use. Eg: park in 2P space, pay for 2 hrs and entitled to an additional 2hrs free of charge



Lost/Stolen/Damaged Permits

- Lost/stolen - permit holder must complete a statutory declaration and pay for a new permit to be issued at the standard fee of \$10.00
- Damaged – if damage is due to faulty manufacturing of permit, you must return to council and we will provide you with a replacement free of charge. Damage caused by the applicant will incur a charge of \$10.00

Permit renewals

- Council will email or post a renewal letter to you at least 14 days before the expiry date of your permit.
- When renewing your permit if you have not changed residential address you will not be required to provide proof of residency.
- Upon renewing you will be required to pay the relevant application fee.

Permit Cancellation

- A permit may be cancelled by council at any time for wilful misuse or breach of the “conditions of use”. Council may impose a penalties for misuse of the permit.
