

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE A LOCAL LAW

DRAFT LOCAL LAW NO. 2: GENERAL PUBLIC AMENITY

In accordance with a resolution of the Golden Plains Shire Council (Council) made at its meeting held on 25 August 2020, notice is given that it is the intention of Council, acting under section 119 of the Local Government Act 1989, to create a new local law.

The proposed Local Law, if made, will replace the Local Law No. 2 – Public Amenity, Roads and Streets (2017).

Lodging submissions
