How was this Plan developed?

Preparation to develop this community plan commenced in May 2017. The Mannibadar Community were asked for ideas and projects via a survey distributed to each resident.

At the Annual Mannibadar Winter Casserole Luncheon in June 2017 a discussion workshop was held with all residents who were present about Projects they would like to see within the upcoming Community Plan.

Consensus was achieved and all Projects decided on that day are what makes up the Mannibadar Community Plan 2017 – 2020.



2017-2020 Community Plan Key Projects

HALL IMPROVEMENTS:

Improvements to our Hall to include such things as:

- Refurbishment of kitchen / second supper room
- Toilet block upgrade
- Re-carpet supper room and hallway
- Painting of main hall ceiling
- Acoustic Panels/sound proofing for the ceiling in supper room and hall
- Fix trim around the edge of the kitchen bench (nails)
- Replace front doors
- Mouse proofing the hall

SEED Funding allocated \$5,000



HISTORY / HERITAGE PROJECTS:

- Memorial for Mannibadar Solider Settlers
- Rock & plaque for primary school site (number of years in operation)
- Begin to plan 100th Anniversary Settlement Celebration – Mannibadar June 2021

SEED Funding allocated \$1500

ADVOCACY PROJECTS:

- Linton / Mannibadar Road Upgrade
- More roadside slashing
- Trim trees at the corner of Geelong Rd and Stretches Rd to get trucks through
- Underground power to Hall and tennis courts (potential subsidy from Powercor)

SOCIAL / RECREATION:

- Tennis nets
- Hot shots equipment
- Community movie night
- Social nights
- Badminton / table tennis activities
- Activities for all ages – including young people and family activities / social gatherings

SEED Funding allocated \$1000

SPEED LIMITS, MAPS AND SIGNAGE:

- Review appropriateness of speed limits
- Signage – Hoyles Creek
- Signs for Linton-Mannibadar Rd at both ends
- School bus signs
- Boundary map / board at Hall for people to see
