# How was this Plan developed?

Preparation to develop this community plan commenced in May 2017. The Ross Creek – Smythes Creek community were asked for ideas and projects via a survey distributed to each resident. 55 survey responses were then collated.

A public forum was then held on the 21st of July at which those present (28 residents) voted to establish the top priorities for the Plan. From this process the following Projects were established as the priorities for the Ross Creek - Smythes Creek Community Plan 2017 – 2020.
