

DECLARATION OF FUTURE STERILISATION OF A DOG

Victorian legislation requires that all dogs and cats 3 months of age must be microchipped and registered with their local Council. To receive a reduced fee for registration, Council requires dogs to be desexed. Some owners who do not intend to breed with their dog and want to delay their dog being desexed may be entitled to a reduced fee for the first year of registration provided a vet completes the following form. Your animal registration will be charged at the higher rate after the first year until a sterilisation certificate is supplied.
