What is Community Planning?

Community Planning is a process where community members come together and take action to improve their community. Community members develop a community plan that outlines projects they will undertake to make their town a better place to live.

Golden Plains Shire Council supports Community Planning by providing a professional facilitator who assists communities, as well as grants to help implement the projects in the community plan.

How was this Plan developed?

Preparation to develop this community plan commenced in October 2017. The Wallinduc community were asked for ideas and projects via a survey distributed to each resident.

At the annual Wallinduc Christmas Party, another opportunity to provide ideas was offered. All those who attended discussed the ideas presented and consensus was reached as to what Projects were important to the Community and therefore were to go into the 2018 – 2021 Wallinduc Community Plan.

The Christmas Party was held on Friday 8th December and was attended by 30 adults and 22 kids. It was a great night for all!

From this process the following 5 Projects were established as the priorities for the Wallinduc Community Plan 2018 – 2021.

2018-2021 Community Plan Key Projects

Children's Playground

Establish a children's playground / play space area at the Wallinduc Community Facilities area.

This space would also include:

- Fencing around the site to make the area safe from the road
- Shade cloth areas
- Additional play equipment accessible (balls, bats etc)

SEED funding allocated: \$3,000

Community Social Nights

Organise a variety of community social nights.

These could include:

- Movie night at the CFA Hall
- Christmas Celebrations
- Harvest Celebrations
- Evening with health speakers on:
 - Male and female health issues
 - Parenting
 - Family health
 - Mental health
- Other social events / nights that bring the community together

SEED funding allocated: \$1,500



Road Improvements & Maintenance

- Fill the holes in the roads near the CFA Shed / Wallinduc facilities
- Advocate for safer intersections where blind spots currently exist:
 - Padgetts Lane & Willowvale Rd where they meet at the Highway (both sides)
 - Wallinduc / Berrybank Rd corner, where it meets the Highway at Wallinduc

Entrance Sign

Develop and install a Town Entrance Sign for Wallinduc.

- Develop the design
- Attain funds
- Work out installation plan etc

SEED funding allocated: \$3,000

Wallinduc Community Facilities

- Secure the mowing of grass around the Wallinduc facility site to be added to the Shire's ongoing maintenance schedule
- Establish the feasibility of an outside toilet & secure bin
