

Information Sheet: Tourist and business signage guidelines

Signage requirements

In order to be eligible an applicant needs to demonstrate that they are:

- 1) A registered business
- 2) A business that requires extra signage for promotion.
- 3) Approval from Council – complete “Tourism and Business Signage Application form” and submit
- 4) Approval from VicRoads if accessed from a VicRoads road and within an 80 km/h zone. If sign is located in a 100km/h zone on a VicRoads Road, then a permit will need to be applied for directly

Where the criteria for signage has been met, Council will undertake to supply and install the signs at the cost of the applicant. Applicant will be invoiced for works undertaken.

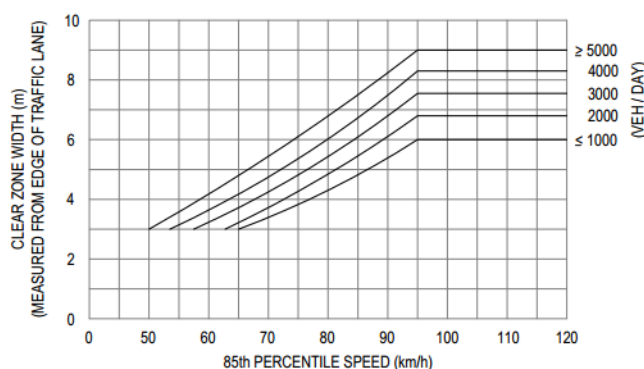
Location of signage

The following guidelines are to be used to determine location of signage.

The applicant will request suitable permission and site will be reviewed within the engineering department, ensuring adequate clear zones on roadsides. However the distance may change if there is any infrastructure in the road side such as drains, power, telephone poles etc.

Maintenance requirements

If the sign is damaged or needs replacement, the applicant will need to replace signage at their expense.
