

Information Sheet: Defibrillator signage

Signage criteria

Community groups within the Golden Plains Shire who submit a request for a directional sign to a Defibrillator need to meet three or more of the following criteria:

- 1) Defibrillator is located in a suitable location and easily accessible by the general public.
- 2) Defibrillator is located in an area which is 24hr accessible.
- 3) Defibrillator is monitored by a security camera.
- 4) Defibrillator is located in a well-lit area.
- 5) Defibrillator is located at a service station, police station or fire station.

Location of signage

The following guidelines are to be used to determined location of signage.

- 1) Installed within 60km township zone unless location i.e. service station, police station or fire station is situated outside this area.
- 2) Consent for location is received from road authority.
- 3) Signage will consist of a standard green logo sign - 150mm fingerboard with overlay on both sides, class 1 White on Green.
